

2010 US Sailing Number Procedure

One of the many benefits of being a CBYRA member is the direct access we provide to US Sailing. Over 40 years ago, US Sailing authorized CBYRA to administer (assign and record) sail numbers for US Sailing. As opposed to one-design classes that have a sail number usually associated with a hull number, the US Sailing sail numbers are typically found on Handicap and Cruising One-Design boats. CBYRA assigned sail numbers are normally five numbers, with the second number being "3" or X3XXX (for example, 63252). These assigned sail numbers are associated with a specific boat and cannot be transferred to a new or different boat. All assigned sail numbers must comply with any relevant class rules and Racing Rules of Sailing (speak with your sail maker for details).

To obtain a new sail number, please provide CBYRA with the following information:

- Name
- Address
- Phone Number
- Email
- CBYRA Member Number
- Boat Name
- Boat Type

In addition, please send a payment to CBYRA in the amount of \$125. Your new sail number will not be processed until your payment is received.
