**Rendezvous:** At 1100 hours in vicinity of Mark "G" (G C "1A") Shad Battery Shoal west of Still Pond, shown on Region 1 Standard Racing Marks. Boats must check in with RC prior to first warning signal.

**Radio:** Boats should monitor VHF 68 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

**Start:** Between yellow flag on RC boat and nearby inflatable or government mark.

**Signals:** RRS 26 (Starting Races):

NOTE: Any start subject to recall or postpone will be started at the end of the class starting sequence in order

**Course:** CBYRA drop mark course or Region 1 Standard Racing Marks as designated by letters displayed on RC boat.

**Finish:** Between yellow flag on RC boat and last mark of course. If course is shortened to a channel mark, RC will set up outside the channel and finish will be perpendicular line to the last mark, disregarding original rounding designation (mark color) if necessary.

**Time Limit:** 4 hours.

**Protests:** Intent to protest may be hailed to RC at finish. Form must be delivered to RC boat prior to 1800. Protest hearing will be at a location designated with further details in the Event Sailing Instructions.

**Awards:** 1<sup>st</sup>/3, 2<sup>nd</sup>/5, 3<sup>rd</sup>/7+ entrants.

**Social:** Post race party with food and refreshments begin at 1730 at Turners Creek. Launch service will be available. Awards will be presented at the party. For more information, see the club web site [www.georgetownracingfleet.com](http://www.georgetownracingfleet.com).
