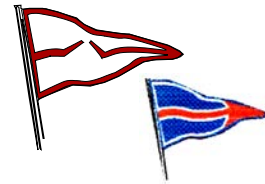

Eligibility:

This race is open to all boats of the following classes:

PHRF A0/A1	PHRF N	Multihull A
PHRF A2	J/30 ^o	Multihull B
PHRF B	J/105 ^o	Beach Cats
PHRF C	Cal 25	

^o – Denotes event does not qualify for CBYRA High Point.

PHRF N competitors are limited to a single headsail in accordance with the PHRF Chesapeake Single Headsail class regulations.

Start: See the Event Sailing Instructions for specifics.

Signals: See the Event Sailing Instructions for specifics.

Course: The course will be a point-to-point race on the Chesapeake Bay, between St. Michael's and Annapolis. The specific course will be defined in the Event Sailing Instructions.

Scoring: PHRF classes will be scored in accordance with the PHRF Time on Time system utilizing PHRF of the Chesapeake Circular Random ratings.

Rules: This race will be governed by the 'Rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

Participants competing in a handicap class shall have a valid 2019 rating certificate.

EYC recommends that each competitor review and prepare their boat to the U.S. Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements, Nearshore. A copy of the Nearshore requirements is available at <http://eastportyc.org/racing>, located under "Racing Resources."

The Event Sailing Instructions will be available no later than Sunday, 12 May 2019 and posted on the Official Notice Board, located electronically at: <http://eastportyc.org/mrrb>.

Awards: 1st/6, 2nd/7, 3rd/9, & 4th/11 finishers.

Social: A cookout and awards party will be held at EYC after racing.

Other: Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

This is a Clean Race; all competitors are strongly encouraged to use multi-use water bottles instead of disposable water bottles, and to recycle whenever possible. A competitor shall not intentionally put trash in the water.
